Term	Learning content/skills
Autumn 1 7 Weeks	<p><u>Weeks 1-4 Animal Farm*(Literature Paper 2: Section A)</u></p> <p>Students will be reintroduced to the studied text. Focus on plot, context, themes and characters as presented in the exam. *This is for current year 11 only (2019/2020) all other future year 11s will study An Inspector Calls by J.B Priestley for this exam.</p> <p><u>Weeks 5-7: Poetry (Literature Paper 2: Section B and C)</u></p> <p>Students will be taught the remaining six poems in AQA Anthology of Power and Conflict Poetry. Language, form and structure are explicitly analysed in preparation for their exams. Students are then taught how to approach unseen poetry and essay style responses to support section C of the exam.</p>
Autumn 2 7 Weeks	<p><u>Week 1-3: Preparation and Revision for PPE Literature Paper 2</u></p> <p>Teachers tailor plan lessons to support the revision and understanding of the PPE. There is a 2-week window across year 11 where all students sit PPE exams.</p> <p><u>Weeks 4-5: Feedback</u></p> <p>Students receive independent reviews and tasks to support their results to the PPEs.</p>



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	<p><u>Weeks 6-7: A Christmas Carol (Literature Paper 1)</u></p> <p>Students receive a two-week scheme to retrieve knowledge on plot, context, theme and character.</p>
<p>Spring 1</p> <p>6 Weeks</p>	<p><u>Week 1: Macbeth (Literature Paper 1)</u></p> <p>This is a Knowledge Retrieval strategy to ensure gaps are not formed in between learning different texts. Students will have reminders to key quotes and themes explored in the text.</p> <p><u>Week 2: A Christmas Carol (Literature Paper 1)</u></p> <p>This is a Knowledge Retrieval strategy to ensure gaps are not formed in between learning different texts.
